Meet Hayes, the warrior super hero, and the reason behind everything at the HayesTough Foundation.

On January 7, 2016, doctors discovered a tumor that took up 1/3 of his brain. After surgery and biopsies, it was discovered that Hayes had an extremely rare and aggressive form of cancer, Choroid Plexus Carcinoma. On January 31, 2016, Hayes began the long journey of treatment where he received six rounds of an extremely high dose of chemo followed by a stem cell transplant.

In November, after only 3 months of remission, Hayes' cancer returned more aggressively than before. On December 3, 2016, Hayes passed away peacefully surrounded by his family.

Hayes still has such a huge impact on the world and the HayesTough Foundation is his way of being able to fulfill that mission.

Lastly, we provide care packages for warriors battling across the country. We can't do this alone. That is where you come in.



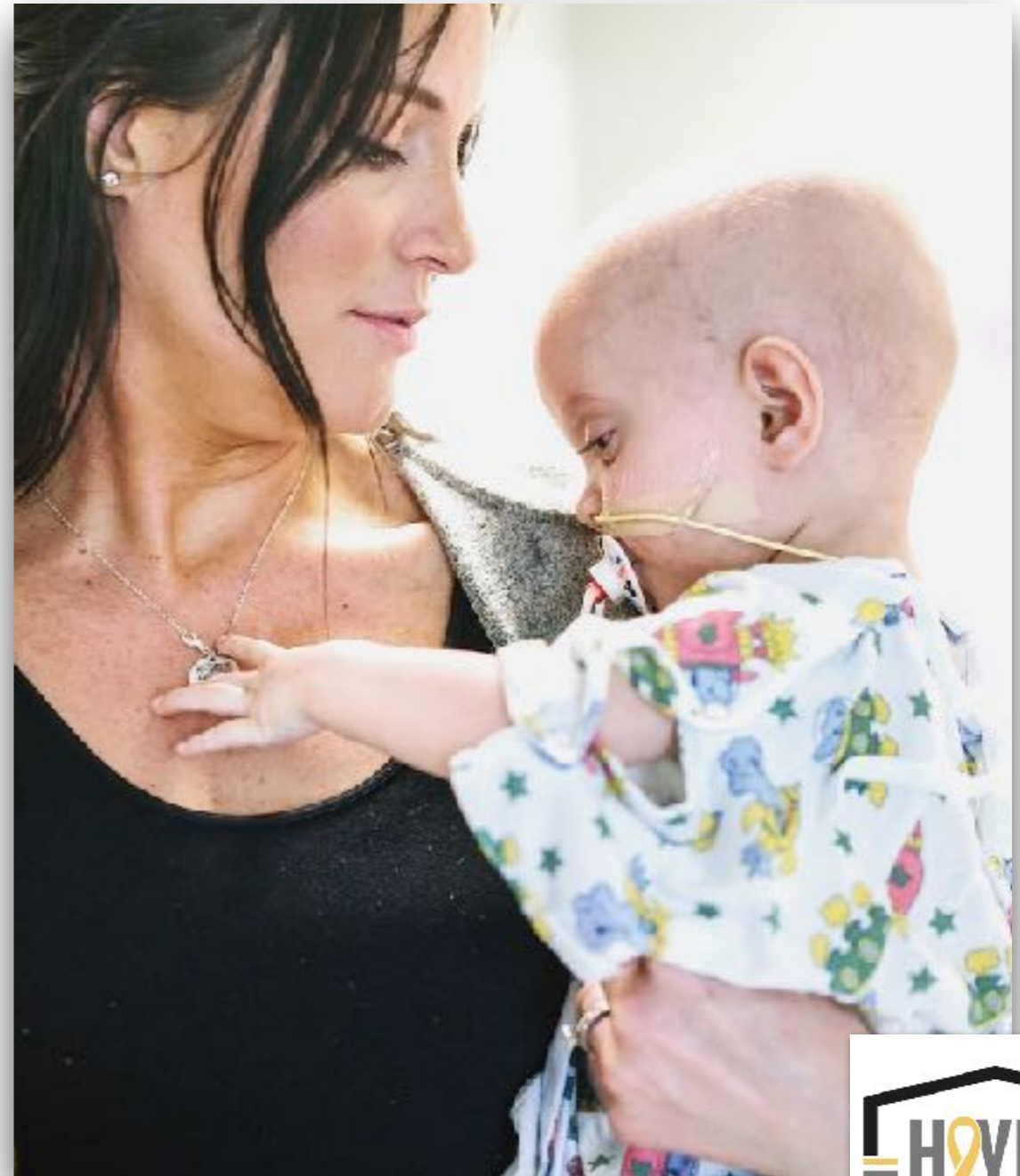
HOW CAN YOU HELP?
